RapidM adheres to local South African legislation, i.e. statutory- and regulatory requirements, and is ISO 9001: 2015 certified. Additionally, it is RapidM's policy to comply with the EU's *Regulation 2017/821*¹ and the USA's *Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act*² by following the *Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas*³ laid out by the *Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development* (OECD).

RapidM is, therefore, committed to report on the supply chain of the conflict minerals tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold (3TG). All relevant suppliers of products and/or services that contain 3TG minerals are required to provide RapidM with a *Responsible Minerals Initiative Conflict Mineral Reporting Template*⁴ (CMRT). Should a supplier be unable/unwilling to comply with RapidM's request, RapidM will make use of alternative suppliers where available.
